

A Note from the Director:

Who would like to be trapped forever in high school? Please, raise your hand! Any takers? Yeah, didn't think there would be very many of you.

High school is brutal. Academic pressure put aside, young people face the day-to-day battle of "fitting in" and often question whether being themselves is enough. The language in *Mean Girls* is triggering; the insults characters give each other reflect only a fraction of verbal abuse young people hear regularly. No matter how much caregivers and mentors might remind youth how precious and beautiful they are, the opinions of their peers are stronger: as Gretchen says, "Mama called me beautiful, don't believe her anymore".

This show is fun—the students love and identify with so many of the characters, and the music is catchy and never gets old. You will hear our Guilders' voices soar, and our pit erupt with enthusiastic playing.

This show is hilarious—from Karen's spacey moments and ridiculous "sexy" costumes to the snarky Ms. Norbury and over the top "cool mom" Mrs. George, audiences of all ages will find themselves laughing.

This show is uncomfortable—from slut-shaming to homophobia, to drug use and cyber-bullying, we get a taste of the humiliating and sometimes dangerous situations young people find themselves in. However, just because it might trigger audiences does not mean it should be ignored; these issues should be recognized and addressed.

Many thanks to our production staff and volunteers for all their hard work! Returning to GV for her third year, Rachel Beiswenger once again cleverly incorporates storytelling into many of her dances. We welcomed two newcomers to our production staff: Joe Gregorio, who skillfully and patiently guides Guilders to be their best sound, and Greg Dippell, whose energy level is always 120% and infuses his pit with a passion for the orchestration. Rob Frankel and Bob Johnson put in much work and humor guiding our Tech Guilders with lights and sound, as well as building of the set (shout out to Kirker family for the toilet donation!). Debbie Young and Karen Barnett led our new team of student costumers with knowledge, warmth and detail. Amit Keshet and Grace Colvin were stage-managers extraordinaire—Drama Guild is nothing without these two!






